In May 2012, we will conduct a campaign to promote the use of the Pre-Authorized Payment (PAP) for donations made to St. Isidore Church. **Volunteers will be available after all masses in May to assist.** If you would like to sign up for PAP please:

- Bring a void cheque;
- Decide whose name should appear on your family tax receipt and;
- Choose how you would like your contribution directed e.g. to the operation of the church and/or to the mortgage fund.

Why You want to use PAP	Why St. Isidore would like you to use PAP
1. Simple for you. No need to prepare and remember your donation every week. Withdraws are direct - no need for cheques. 2. Your much-needed donation makes its way to the church even in your absence (e.g. summer vacation) 3. Personal bank reconciliation made easy.
